“One Minute for Peace” was launched for the first time on June 6, 2014 at 1 p.m.,

in support of the “Invocation for Peace” meeting, promoted by Pope Francis on June 8 in the Vatican Gardens together with the President of Israel (Simon Peres), the President of the Palestinian Authority (Maḥmūd ‘Abbās – Abu Mazen), and the Patriarch of Constantinople (Bartholomew I).
